*You do not need to come to campus during registration week 21-25 January unless you need a \*Student Finance appointment.*

## What you need to do for registration:

- *Student Finance England students, please included your SFE entitlement letter for the 18/19 academic year, if you have not already provided it to CRIC.*



### 2. Finance & Fees

- *Self-funded students, please pay your tuition fees in full. Check your AXIS Finance profile.*
- *Student Finance England students If you do not have your entitlement letter by Friday 11 January you will need to book a \* Student Finance appointment. (See below.)*



### 3. You must update your eVision

*Login into <https://e-vision.anglia.ac.uk>*

*Username: Your ARU Computer login. (e.g. CR75); Password: Your ARU Computer password.*

*You should update your contact details and if applicable re-register on eVision.*



### Timetable released during registration week.

*Your timetable will be released on Axis from Monday 21st January 48 hours after completing the above steps.*
